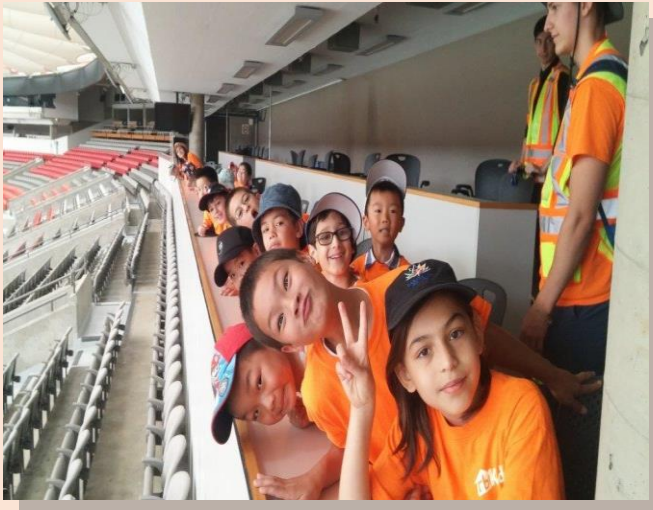

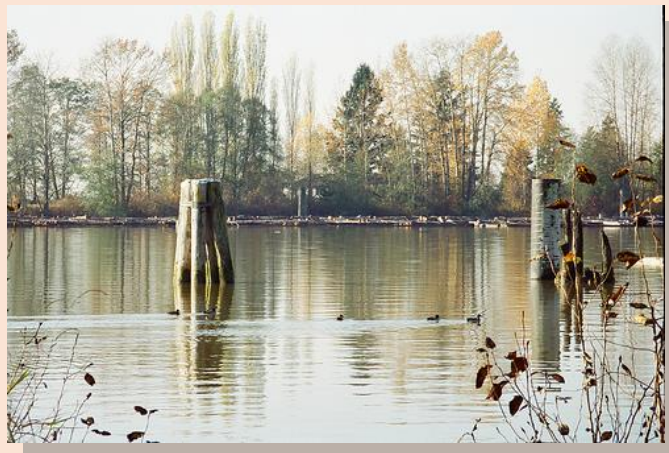
This summer we will be running a special program in July and August for Elementary children who are entering Grade 1 to Grade 7 as of September 2018.



The Summer Camp Program will operate Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The children will be dropped off to their Summer Camp Leader at the picnic tables outside the Kelowna Cafe, or at Burnaby Foreshore Park depending on the week. Any necessary changes in the drop off and pick up area due to specialized weeks will be announced by the camp leader.

Spaces are limited, so be sure to book your child quickly if you wish to utilize this great summer program! Please complete a registration form for each child that you wish to enroll in the program. We will review your requested weeks and send you

confirmation within one week of receiving your registration form. In collaboration with the City of Burnaby Parks and Recreation Department, we will be holding our Summer Camp Program at a designated area within the Foreshore Park! This park is located across the street from Ritchie Bros. Auctioneers.



Weekly Summer Camp Themes for Grades 1 – Grade 7

JULY 2018

Week 1 – Exploring Parks N More Camp – July 3rd to July 6th

Please note we are closed July 2nd - In lieu of Canada Day

Let's explore the natural beauty of our local parks. We will learn about nature, visit some water parks & help take care of animals in a petting zoo. We will also enjoy some trails, play some fun games & have an opportunity to get creative with a variety of art projects.

Week 2 – Experience the Wonders and Treasures of China Town – July 10th to July 14th

These young explorers will learn some interesting facts and history of China town, visit some Chinese restaurants and enjoy some tasty food. We will visit Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese gardens, create some ancient arts, and have a guided tour of China town. The children will also have fun playing a variety of sport activities, arts and crafts related to this week's theme.



Week 3 - Discover Vancouver's Museums and Galleries – July 16th to July 20th

Our young art enthusiasts and history buffs will have an opportunity to visit the Burnaby Art Gallery and enjoy a picnic lunch in the park. We will also visit the Burnaby village museum which is an open-air museum where history comes to life in the 1920's. As part of our visit we will take a ride on a restored 1912 C.W. Parker Carousel. The children will also have an opportunity to visit and tour the Canadian Museum of Flight!! Bring Your Camera! In addition to exploring children will have a chance to participate in drawing, painting, and sculpture activities related to this week's theme.

Week 4 – Stanley Park beaches, Trails and More! - July 23rd to July 27th

We will discover the wonders and hidden treasures of Stanley park! The children will be spending 2 days exploring and visiting different areas of this amazing park. They will learn about the history as well as enjoy a visit to the beach. Enjoy some local culinary delights and much more. A variety of arts, crafts, and sport activities will be available each day.



AUGUST 2018

Week 5 – RB Kids Sports Galore & More – July 30th to August 3rd

This is an active camp where the children will have an opportunity to learn and play a variety of different sports and games. These will include volleyball, soccer, badminton, softball and more. We will be visiting the Richmond Oval rock climbing wall, and we will be touring roger's arena! We will also enjoy a variety of games, arts & crafts.

Week 6 – Exploring Steveston Village – Kite design & Flying – August 7th to August 10th

Please note we are closed August 6th - BC Day

This week the children will learn all about the history of Steveston, make their own kites. Visit the cannery, take a tour of the Britannia ship yards' historic site, enjoy a picnic lunch and take a walk down fisherman's Warf. In addition, we will have a variety of games, arts, and crafts available each day related to our experiences.



Week 7 – Tons O Fun Camp – August 14th to August 18th

Yeah! We will be visiting a variety of different venues including bowling ally's, and checking out the Vancouver White Caps. We will also try our hand at making sushi. This week is sure to be action packed and full of surprises... Did someone say Pizza!!

Week 8 – Beach Sand and Ocean Camp August 20st to August 24th

We will be having an exciting week of exploring and learning about our local beaches, what we find and see! We will be visiting two beaches and enjoying a fun filled beach party complete with great food, sand castles contests and beach ball fun, a variety games, arts and crafts will be available each day!

Week 9 – Space & Science Camp - August 27th to August 31st

Spaces are only secured once we have received payment in full for your desired weeks and there are NO REFUNDS for cancelled weeks due to illness, personal family schedule changes, weather or other situations.

Important Notes for Parents

- All our summer program weeks also include a range of arts, crafts and fun learning activities that are related to the weekly theme. This year the program is an outdoor based camp – at the Foreshore Park and other various areas of the Lower Mainland. Each day will include organized activities, walking trips and time for relaxation. We will be offering theme-related field trips, which would cost an additional fee as stated in the registration. We will provide advance notice to families for these weeks.
- **Please note the RBA Summer Program is a nut free-program due to severe, life threatening allergies.**
- All parents are required to complete emergency medical permission forms, and other related consent paperwork prior to their child commencing the weekly programs. These forms will be provided to you after we receive your initial registration form indicating the week(s) you wish to enroll your child for **AND** payment cheque.
- There will be an email sent to you once your child's registration has been confirmed. This email will contain the necessary information for your child to have a great week with us. **Please note field trip information will go out the first day of each week.**
- **RBA Corporate Child Care Services and the Summer Day Camp strive to offer programs that are as inclusive as possible. If your child has any health or learning challenges that we should be aware of please be sure to advise us of this on the registration forms, we send you to complete. We will book a personal or telephone meeting time with you so as to better understand your child's needs. If your child currently receives additional support services while at school or has an IEP in place, please discuss this with us. In some cases, we will be required to develop our own care plan prior to a child participating in our summer day camp experiences. Examples of health or learning challenges we need to be made aware of include: ADHD, ADD, Autism, OCD, learning disabilities, anxiety, other mental health disorders, life threatening illnesses or allergies as well as specific physical challenges. While we try our very best to support all children, in some cases this may prove to not be possible either due to limited resources or an incorrect match between the camp experience and the child's needs. Should this occur, we will discuss the situation with you personally.**
- **Field trip dates will be announced on the first day of the week your child(ren) are in attendance. The price of the camp does not include the cost of transportation or admission to various destinations.**
